SIGNIFICANCE

Handsome Folk Victorian residence from the late 19th century. Notable features include cornice with paneled frieze and scrolled brackets, hipped-roof front porch, and two-story east side bay.

HISTORIC FEATURES

Hipped roof; cornice with paneled frieze and brackets; hipped roof porch with turned porch columns and railings and spindlework frieze (may be early alteration from the 1890s); two-story, three-sided bay on east facade; some windows on first floor appear to be historic wood double hung windows

ALTERATIONS


Second-story windows are wood replacement; rear deck addition (1996)
