SIGNIFICANCE

Building may be eligible for local landmark designation for its associations with the history and development of communications in the Village of Libertyville. The building replaced an earlier office erected at the same location in 1923.

HISTORIC FEATURES

Red brick exterior; ribbon windows connected with horizontal concrete surrounds; main entrance at ground level set within a slightly projecting overhang capped with concrete, with a row of casement windows stretching beside the doorway within a concrete-clad wall.

ALTERATIONS

Two story rear additions (1956 and 1968); front window east of entry bricked in $\,$
