SIGNIFICANCE

Rare, post-World War II Expressionist design in Libertyville. The building is an early design by architect Rodney H. Wright, who lived and worked in Libertyville in the early-to-mid-1960s. Wright was later known for his work on passive solar design and the design of child care facilities.

HISTORIC FEATURES

Complex massing and butterfly roofline; pyramidal skylight jutting from center of the building; obscured entrance; vertical windows
